




Math Classroom Student View

After logging in, you will enter the BookNook Math Classroom. Here you will see the tutor and student video on the right as well as additional controls along the top, left, and bottom of the whiteboard screen.

View the **Class information** here.

If your tutor has enabled drawing tools, you will be able to use the **whiteboard tools** here to draw, type, draw shapes, and erase!

This is where the **undo** and **redo** buttons are as well as where you can **zoom in and out**. You can use the reset button to instantly snap the zoom back to 100%.

Here you can turn **on/off your camera and mic**, share your screen (if your tutor has turned that feature on) and **raise your hand** to get your tutor's attention.

Follow Mode: You will see "Following ____" if your tutor has set up the whiteboard to follow their screen.

You should see your tutor and your **video screen** here.

Use the text **chat**, change your **mic** and **camera settings**, and **exit** the session.

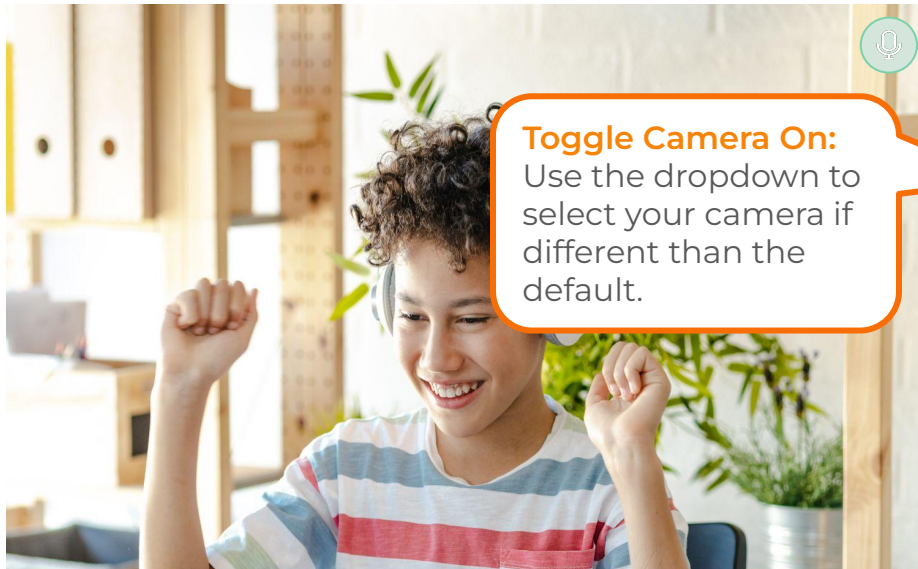
Mic Camera Share Raise

When you first join the Math Classroom, please be sure students turn on their video & audio. If not using Chrome (our preferred browser) and are using an iPad, take additional steps to toggle "Block Pop Ups" off under Settings > Safari.



After logging in, you will set up your camera and microphone for your tutoring session. Be sure you can see and hear yourself before clicking join!

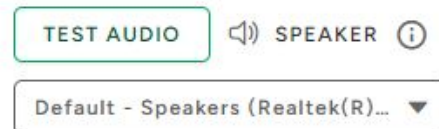


Toggle Camera On: Use the dropdown to select your camera if different than the default.

Audio and video settings



Toggle Microphone On: Use the dropdown to select your microphone if different than the default.



Test Audio: Click to play a short audio clip to test your audio. Adjust your volume with the slider.



Join: Click to join after you turn on your camera and microphone!

BACKGROUND (Background effects might not be available on some devices)



Background Options: Use your default background, blur your background, or select from the included options.


Please note, you may need to give the browser permission to access your video and audio - click "allow" when prompted.



SUPPORTING STUDENTS

3-Point Check to Test

We recommend these 3 points to check before students click join.



1 See self in camera view.

2 See mic levels changing when speaking.

3 Audio can be heard when "Test Audio" selected
