

## Set Details:

- Includes 3 printable border pieces per page
- Each individual piece prints approximately 10.5 inches in length

## Directions:

### 1. Measure Your Bulletin Board

- Each border piece is approximately 10.5 inches in length, and one printed page contains 31.5 inches of border (3 pieces per page).
- To determine how many pages to print, follow these steps:
  1. Measure the length and width of your bulletin board.
  2. Divide each side's measurement by 31.5, then round up to the nearest whole number.
  3. Multiply that number by 2 (for both top/bottom and sides).

### Example Calculation:

- Top/Bottom:  $52.5 \text{ inches} \div 31.5 = 1.6 \rightarrow$  Round up to 2 pages per side (4 pages total for both).
- Sides:  $36 \text{ inches} \div 31.5 = 1.14 \rightarrow$  Round up to 2 pages per side (4 pages total for both).
- Total: 8 pages for the entire border.

*Tip: Print one extra page to account for overlap.*

### 2. Print the Borders

- Open the PDF file in your preferred PDF viewer (e.g., Adobe Reader).
- Use the following print settings for best results:
  - ✓ **Page Size:** Set to Actual Size or 100% to avoid scaling.
  - ✓ **Orientation:** Ensure Landscape is selected.
- Optional:
  - ✓ Print on cardstock for added durability.
  - ✓ Laminate the borders for long-term use.

### 3. Assemble and Attach the Borders

- Cut out each border piece along the lines.
- Arrange the pieces end-to-end around your bulletin board:
  - ✓ Option 1: Tape the pieces together at the ends before attaching them to the board.
  - ✓ Option 2: Staple or tape the pieces directly to the bulletin board as you go.
- Slightly overlap the edges of each piece for seamless alignment.
