

Let students reflect on their BookNook experience by creating a personalized scene of their tutoring sessions! These blackline templates are modeled after the virtual Reading Classroom. [View the Math Classroom version here.](#)

Full-Size Printing (8.5 x 11 inch paper):

1. Open the PDF file in your preferred PDF viewer (e.g., Adobe Reader).
2. Select Print and ensure the following settings:
 - ✓ **Page Size:** Set to Actual Size or 100% to avoid scaling.
 - ✓ **Orientation:** Select Landscape if not automatically detected.
3. Print **page 3** for each student.

Ideas for Use:

- Use this activity at the end of a program or after any session.
- **End-of-Program Keepsake**
 - Have students draw themselves, their tutor, and then draw and/or write about their favorite part of BookNook tutoring. This could be a game, activity, book, or any moment they loved and want to share about.
- **Session Wrap-Up Reflection** - Use after a tutoring session to help students reflect on:
 - Their favorite part of that day's lesson
 - What the lesson was about
 - A new vocabulary word they learned
 - Something that was difficult at first but they figured out
 - Something that was new or surprising to them
- **Review the layout of the virtual classroom:**
 - Point out the microphone, camera, chat, and settings buttons in the reading classroom
 - Remind students to color the "Enter" button green - "Green Means Go!"
- **Display** finished drawings on a BookNook-themed bulletin board in your classroom or hallway.
- Encourage students to **share their work with their tutors** - it's a meaningful way to celebrate connections!

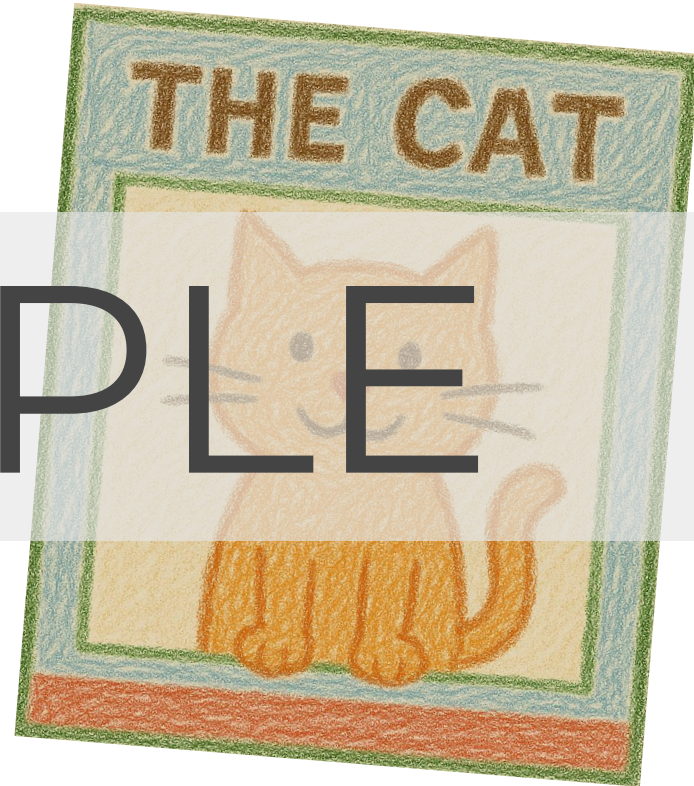

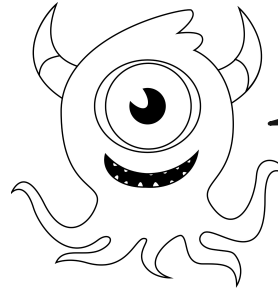
